ETIQUETTE FOR A SURREALIST EVENING



A.1: Upon arrival, each guest must procure a CARD. A guest may not leave until he/she/it has presented the HOST or HOSTESS with a fully filled card. It need not be the card he or she or it began with, and UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES may a guest fill more than one segment of any specific card.

A.2: Before each visit to the TOILET, each guest must kiss another guest on the cheek. This is the SYGN. A different guest must be kissed for each visit. If you run out of guests, you must find another. Once in the toilet, kindly pluck one PUBIC HAIR and affix to the paper provided, labelled with your name and time of plucking. Tweezers provided.

B.3: At 10PM, we all stop for a moment of SILENCE, preceded by a BLESSING by the host or hostess. HAND-HOLDING is encouraged during this BLESSING.



- Contradict yourself regularly


